1. General Introduction of Pattaya, Thailand:



Pattaya is a city in Thailand, which is well known for beach resorts, and is popular with tourists and expatriates. It is located on the east coast of the Gulf of Thailand, about 165 km southeast of Bangkok within but not part of Amphoe Bang LamungBanglamungin the province of Chonburi.

Event Groupings:

The events will be divided into two Groups, A and B for scheduling purposes .If the two Groups are run on the same day, they would be held as separate sessions, e.g .Group A in the morning; Group B in the afternoon.

2.5 Entries

Preliminary Entry must be received by 4th July 2017. The Preliminary Entry must include the events to be entered, the total number of athletes in the team, and the number of officials accompanying the team.

Final Entry is due by 4th August, 2017. The completed Final Entry must include all necessary information for each crew, including name with date of birth of each athlete, all team members and substitutes and officials.

Entry Forms for Preliminary and Final Entries are attached to this Bulletin .They should be competed and forwarded to the Organizing Committee, with a copy to ARF headquarters, by the stipulated date.

Late Entry: Will not be entertained. Please note that late entries will DEFINITELY NOT be accepted after the final entry lists have been published, or at the Team Manager's meetings.

2.6 Weather

3. Transportation:

Organizing Committee will arrange transport during the event. Special transport will be arranged for Para-rowing personnel. The cost of transportation from Suwannabhumi International Airport or Donmeang International Airport to official hotel in Pattaya is 50 USD/person (Round Trip)

4. Boats and Equipment

All boats and other equipment must comply with FISA Rules of Racing. The OC will provide **boats** for rent. Requests for hiring boats should be submitted to "boatrental@swiftinternational.biz" using **the attached Boat and Oars Rental** Form on or before 4th June 2017.

After this date there is no guarantee of boat availability.

(The boat rental charges are as follows) USD /per boat /per day (Single scull) 1x (\$50) (Double scull) 2x (& Pair) 2 (-\$60) (Four & Quadruple Scull) 4-, 4x (\$70) (Eight) 8 (+\$100)

Each team is highly recommended to bring their own oars and sculls. The OC will provide **Croker oars** for rent.

If you need to rent oars and sculls the rate is \$ 15/pair scull / per day, \$ 20/pair sweep/ per day.

Bike rentals will also be available for coaches during the training period. The charge is \$10 per day.

5. Accommodation and Meals:

D VareeJomtien Beach is an upscale 38-story hotel located on the beautiful Jomtien beach of Pattaya with a mere two-hour drive away from Bangkok .Along the straight beach road, there are plenty of souvenir shops, food stalls, restaurants and activities to be found .The transportation around the Pattaya and Jomtien area is pleasant .

D VareeJomtien Beach will be the official hotel .Bookings should be made through the Organizing Committee by 4^{th} July 2017.

Remarks

^{*} Nationals of Brazil, Republic of Korea and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil, Republic of Korea and Peru.

^{**} If such nationals enter the Kingdom at the immigration checkpoints which border neighboring countries, they will be allowed to stay for 15 days each time, except (1) Malaysian nationals who cross the borderline from Malaysia, (2) Nationals of the G7 countries: USA, UK, Canada, France, Germany, Italy and Japan, whose granted period of stay will not exceed 30 days each time. In addition, such nationals who hold diplomatic and official passports are also practically exempted from visa for tourism.

7. Insurance:

All Indivisuals Jury, Team Officials &Paticipants are required to possess health and travel insurance.
