

ARF Umpiring Committee Jury Selection Principles

General

- 1) Two or more nominees (highly welcome different genders) from the same MF for the same event can be nominated. In this case, preference for selection by the MF is accepted if the MF's preference is consistent with this Jury Selection Principles.
- 2) Regional balance (East Asia, South-East Asia, Central & West Asia). Not only Jury members but also Spare juries are basically appointed per each region.
- 3) Variety of MFs.
- 4) Gender balance.
- 5) Increased developing juries having less experience (developed juries having much experience can be appointed at WR events).
- 6) Increased juries whose MF is hosting the event.
- 7) Good feedback on activities, communication and behavior of the nominee concerned at previous WR and ARF events.

Asian Games Regatta

- 1) Basically 1 jury per MF except for the hosting MF.
- 2) Both regional and gender balance are highly considered.
- 3) Experience of jury at Asian Senior Championships or Asian Junior Championships as well as one or more WR events.

Asia & Oceania Olympic Qualification Regatta

- 1) Basically 1 jury per MF except for the hosting MF.
- 2) Both regional and gender balance are highly considered.
- 3) Experience of jury at Asian Senior Championships or Asian Junior Championships as well as one or more WR events.
